I. Introduction

a) What is Gazelle Accelerator?

The Gazelle Accelerator programme aims at supporting existing technology-based companies, SMEs, start-ups and scale-ups, by accelerating their international business, innovation and financial capacities.

The programme targets technology-based companies (SMEs, start-ups and scale-ups), that are developing solutions in the 4.0 industry: Analytics & AI; Internet of Things; Simulated and Augmented/Virtual Reality; Collaborative and Mobile Industrial Robots; Agile Manufacturing applications.

III. Description of the expected servicesa) Methodology

In collaboration with Aerospace Valley, and the other members of the consortium, the company will have the following mission: creation of a website as a "one page" website to present Gazelle Accelerator Programme. The website shall contain at least:

- A short description of the programme, our partnership with the EIT Manufacturing, the consortium and the scope of Industry 4.0;
- The benefits for each actors (startups/corporates/investors) to participate;
- Key numbers (start-ups engaged, countries, use cases, etc.);
- Videos of the startups who participated (they will be provided) + testimony;
- A contact form to join the Gazelle Accelerator Team;
- Links for LinkedIn, Twitter;
- A page with news & events, that after the website is finished, we can update easily with news and new events about Gazelle Accelerator;
- A page with all the startups accelerated with their description, logos and websites, that we can easily update with new start-ups;
- Privacy and cookies policy;
- \circ $\;$ Some graphics are already available but new ones will have to be created;
- All the texts will be provided by Aerospace Valley;
- Some animations included (e.g. zoom when the mouse is on the picture, graphics elements in motion on the website...);









- Development of the website via content management system (CMS);
- Compatible with Edge, Internet Explorer, Safari, Firefox, Chrome and working under Windows, Mac OS or Linux; on smartphone and digital tablet;
- The website must be responsive and all its content must be editable at all time;
- 2 hours online training for 2 people to become autonomous to update the website once it's finished (e.g. update the news & events, update the videos of the start-ups with new testimony, new partners in the projects added in 2022, new start-ups to be added in the website or deleted...);
- The website must show the business creation, the innovation and the dynamics of the project Gazelle Accelerator;
- Transfer of the website's rights to Aerospace Valley;

Good to know: we already have a hosting and domain name for the website, this has not to be included in the quotation.

- If there is sub-contracting and if yes which part is sub-contracted;
- Detailed price quotation.
